

Seneca Residence Virtual Tour Written Description.

Two-Bedroom Suite – King City Campus.



This description is provided for users that are using screen-readers or cannot access the 3D Virtual Tour.

The linked Virtual Tour for Seneca Residence King Campus shows a staged ‘standard’ suite. This suite has been decorated to show what it could look like after you move-in.

You enter the suite into the kitchenette. To the right of the entrance is a Caesarstone countertop, a stainless-steel fridge against the wall, and a stainless-steel microwave. This suite was renovated in 2018 and also has two white cabinets below the countertop, with two drawers. Above the countertop is an open storage space, and the microwave sits there.

In the corner of the kitchenette is a table and two chairs. This table has been decorated and includes a sign that says ‘home sweet home’. The floor is a grey vinyl plank that also flows into the washroom.

To the left of the entrance is a three-piece washroom. There is a stand-up shower, a toilet, and a vanity with large mirror and sink.

There are two private bedrooms in this suite.

In the bedroom on the left you’ll find a Double XL bed – it’s the same width as a double, but as long as a queen-sized bed. This bed has been decorated with a pillow that has a fox on it. There’s an open closet space, that has a rack for hanging clothes and a shelf above it. There’s a desk with a chair on wheels, and a dresser with three drawers. On top of the dresser is a 32” TV. On the wall in this suite is a thermostat that will control the temperature for the entire suite. There are black-out blinds, and outside of the window is some green space.

In the bedroom on the right is also a Double XL bed, a desk with a chair on wheels and a dresser with three drawers. This bed has been decorated with pillows that say ‘Adventure Awaits’. On top of the dresser is also a 32” TV. The closet space in this suite is smaller, with a wall partially hiding part of the shelf/clothes rack. The floor in both suites is a dark grey carpet. There are black-out blinds, and outside of the window is some green space.
